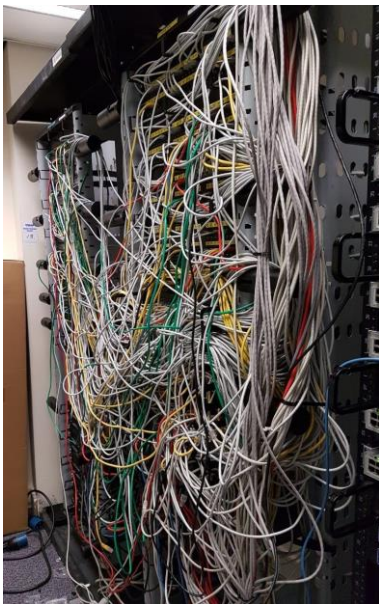
## Cabinetry Organising

### Overview

With your network cabinet being the backbone and foundation of your IT systems, messy, disorganised cabling can lead to disastrous system failures and in worst case scenarios, fire.



#### Our challenge

To re-patch 100s of cables across a number of densely crowded cabinets for a variety of customers to bring order and neatness to their network racks.

#### What we did

Once a patching schedule had been made, we set about removing the mass of interwoven, criss-crossed cables from each of the cabinets. Where required, the cables were replaced with appropriate length patch leads, ensuring proper bend radius, labelled to the customer's requirements and neatly placed within horizontal cable managers or tied with cable ties/Velcro tape.



#### The Result

A number of much neater cabinets with logical cable management enabling the required air flow to ensure efficiency and longevity of not only the equipment but also the cables.

Future maintenance and repairs made easier decreasing downtime, whilst allowing for business growth.
